

## **Ithaca Falls**

Nearest community: Ithaca, NY  
County: Tompkins  
An amazing 150-foot waterfall



### **What you will see:**

As you can see this is a spectacular waterfall. Note the 4 young ladies from Buffalo, New York at the base of the falls posing for a picture. It gives you the perspective of the height, power and grandeur of this impressive falls.

### **How to get there:**

Physical address: 305-357 Lake Street, Ithaca, NY - Crossroad E. Lincoln Street.

Directions: From I-81, take Exit 12 (Homer/Cortland) and follow Route 281 south for 3.8 miles to Route 13. Follow Route 13 south for 18.5 miles and exit at Route 34 North/Stewart Park. Turn right toward Route 34 and follow it 0.1 miles. Turn right onto Route 34 (Lake Street.). Follow it 0.8 miles and turn left

into the parking area at the corner of E. Lincoln Street, just past the bridge.

Trail note: From the parking area go back down to the road and use the sidewalk to walk back to the bridge. Just before the bridge you will see the trail on your right. It is only a 0.15 mile walk to this great falls.

**GPS readings:**

Parking area: N 42° 27.133' W 076° 29.651'

Falls: N 42°27.157' W 076°29.554'

**Cautions:**

Footing can be difficult on this short but rocky trail. Good footwear and cautions are in order.

**Pet friendly?** Yes, but leash required.

**Time:**

This is a very short trek up to a great waterfall.

**Season Hours, Fees, Parking:**

We consider this a 4-season trail to view the falls during daylight hours. There are no fees. There are two levels of free parking. The upper level, which we recommend, has parking for about 7 vehicles. The lower parking area has room for about 3 vehicles.
